1) Choose 3 Books

Select a total of 3 books from the recommended reading lists lists found at http://read.dadeschools.net under the Reading List tab; Elementary Fiction and/or Elementary Nonfiction. You can check-out the books listed from the public library or the M-DCPS Online Catalog public library.

- · 1 Fiction book
- · 1 Non-Fiction book
- Free-Choice book (kindergarten or first grade level)

Hint: Students are welcome to read more than 3 books, but you must complete activities for at least three books.

2) Complete Activities (Tic-Tac-Toe Style)

Choose **one activity for each book** from the Tic-Tac-Toe board. Aim to complete three in a row- horizontally, vertically, or diagonally.

3) Fill Out Your Summer Reading Passport

Complete a passport entry for each book you read-including the 3 books you used for Tic-Tac-Toe and any other books you read.

4) Submit Your Work

Turn in all completed activities and your Summer Reading Passport to your teacher by Friday, August 22, 2025.
